Our Daily Work

There are an estimated 880 mountain gorillas (Gorilla beringei beringei) left in the world, and their close cousin the Grauer's gorilla (Gorilla beringei grauerei) is also critically endangered. Most mountain gorillas and an increasing number of Grauer's gorillas are habituated to the presence of people, which allows tourists from around the world to visit gorillas in their native forests in Rwanda, Uganda and Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC). Tourism brings in revenue, which in turn helps the countries protect and patrol the parks where gorillas live. Habituation also allows Gorilla Doctors and the park workers we train to observe gorillas for signs of illness or injury. This year, Gorilla Doctors performed more than 330 routine health checks and monitoring visits to follow up on reports of ill or injured gorillas.

Saving Lives

For more than 30 years, Gorilla Doctors' most important work has been to provide life-saving veterinary care to gorillas suffering from human-induced illness or injury. This year, our veterinary teams in Rwanda, Uganda and DRC performed 41 clinical interventions on wild gorillas, including delivery of antibiotics to many gorillas suffering from respiratory illnesses. Some of this year's cases were among our most complicated ever, including a juvenile named Agasozindatwa in Volcanoes National Park (Rwanda) who suffered from severe progressive neurologic disease requiring intensive daily treatments. We also removed snares from the limbs of four gorillas this year, including an infant mountain gorilla, Bahoze, in Virunga National Park and an adult female Grauer's gorilla, Busime, in Kahuzi-Biega National Park, DRC.

Finding Answers

While the death of a gorilla is always a sad event for Gorilla Doctors and our partners, a post-mortem examination is an opportunity to learn as much as possible about the health threats gorillas face. This year, Gorilla Doctors took huge steps towards improving capacity in the region for veterinary pathology. Thanks to generous donors who made the purchases of key equipment possible, and working over the internet with Gorilla Doctors' veterinary pathologist Dr. Linda Lowenstine and a dedicated group of volunteer wildlife pathologists in the United States, Gorilla Doctors determined the cause of death in 23 gorillas and other forest wildlife, substantially reducing the wait time between when an animal's carcass is found and when we know why the gorilla died.

Counting Gorillas

Conserving eastern gorillas in Rwanda, Uganda and DRC is a tremendous team effort. This year all three governments and several gorilla organizations led by the International Gorilla Conservation Programme came together to conduct a months-long census to count all mountain gorillas living in the Virunga Massif. Gorilla Doctors made sure all census workers first went through our preventive health program, and we put together field sampling kits. Drs. Ricky and Gaspard joined the field teams for weeks in the parks, carefully documenting night nests and collecting fecal specimens for genetic testing.

Caring for Orphans

Gorilla Doctors continues to provide veterinary care for orphaned mountain gorillas Ndeze, Ndakazi, Maisha and Matabishi at the Senkwekwe Center in Virunga National Park. This year, we also cared for Grauer's gorilla infants Kalonge and Lulingu, who were rescued from poachers in DRC. These two infants are now at the GRACE center in Tayina, DRC, where they joined a family of 14 other Grauer's gorillas. Also this year, Gorilla Doctors cared for a confiscated infant chimpanzee at our Kinigi facility until he too could be moved to a more appropriate sanctuary in Lwiro, outside Kahuzi-Biega National Park, DRC.

Advancing Veterinary Medicine

Gorilla Doctors are among the most skilled wildlife veterinarians in the region - the result of a commitment to our veterinarians acquiring skills and knowledge through unique training opportunities and advanced degree programs. This year, Drs. Eddy, Fred and Noel started Master's degrees in Wildlife Management at Makerere University in Kampala, Uganda, guided by our Capacity-building Coordinator Dr. John Bosco Nizeyi and thanks to support from the Houston Zoo. They are now embarking upon thesis projects, thereby contributing greatly to Gorilla Doctors ongoing research program on health threats facing eastern gorillas. We also hired Dr. Luis Flores to spend a year at the Lwiro Sanctuary outside Kahuzi-Biega National Park to help young Congolese veterinarians gain handson training to become excellent primate and wildlife clinicians.

One Health

Gorilla Doctors was one of the first great ape conservation organizations to recognize the importance of ensuring that the people who come into daily contact with mountain and Grauer's gorillas do not themselves pose an infectious disease risk to the gorillas. Through our Gorilla Conservation Employee Health Program, park workers are screened annually by a physician. Their spouses and children also receive quarterly deworming medication and health and hygiene education. This year, Gorilla Doctors coordinated more than 3,000 preventive health care interventions for park personnel and their family members in Rwanda and the DRC.

Surveillance for Health Threats

Since 2009, Gorilla Doctors has been the implementing partner in Rwanda, Uganda and eastern DRC for a global initiative called the Emerging Pandemic Threats PREDICT project. Funded by USAID and led by Gorilla Doctors Board member Dr. Jonna Mazet at the UC Davis One Health Institute, PREDICT discovers viruses in wildlife that could pose a health threat to people. This serves the health of mountain and Grauer's gorillas too, because viruses that infect people can also infect gorillas. The improved infrastructure for diagnostics and surveillance that PREDICT has enabled has advanced our ability to conduct laboratory testing of gorilla samples in the region. In fact, this year a new laboratory partner in Rwanda started screening wildlife samples for viruses in-country for the first time.

In the Spotlight

This year Gorilla Doctors enjoyed fantastic coverage on television worldwide. In Fall 2015, John Bishop and Tigress Productions filmed an episode for ITV in the UK, which aired on December 28 and ultimately received the prestigious Panda Award for Popular Broadcast, which recognizes "creative and imaginative treatment of compelling stories." Also, CBS television news correspondent Lara Logan brought her 60 Minutes crew to the region in summer 2016, where they documented a snare removal from a Grauer's gorilla in the DRC's Kahuzi-Biega National Park. The episode aired October 9, and the special 360 Virtual Reality version posted on 60 Minutes' Facebook page smashed their traffic records, bringing in several million viewers from around the world.



Wildlife Health

Gorilla Doctors is often called upon to help our government partners with other wildlife. This year we investigated causes of illness and mortality in many endangered golden monkeys in Rwanda. Drs. Mike and Eddy spent two weeks in August helping Virunga National Park and Save the Elephants anesthetize 15 wild forest elephants so that the park could put tracking collars on them to help provide protection from poachers. We also helped Virunga National Park monitor wild chimpanzees that are undergoing human-habituation to facilitate tourism. Our team in Rwanda helped rescue a golden jackal from a snare set outside Volcanoes National Park, and were ready to provide emergency treatment for an orphan forest elephant who wandered outside of the park.




